COVID-19 INFORMATION

Exhibitors, judges, volunteers, and spectators will be required to comply with all Facility, Local and State mandates in place at the time of the event.

BE PREPARED TO WEAR A MASK IN THE RING IF YOUR JUDGE HAS REQUESTED THAT EXHIBITORS BE MASKED.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

All classes will be held indoors, as conditions permit at the time Grooming will be outdoors.

Covered grooming space and electric power are not provided BRING YOUR OWN POP-UP TENT AND GENERATOR

Space is available for grooming at your vehicle and for maintaining sufficient distance between vehicles. Grooming space is also available in designated grassy areas.

- Masks are optional in the building for fully vaccinated exhibitors.
- Judges have the right to require masks in their ring.
- Six foot Social Distancing is required.
- Use hand sanitizer.
- Adhere to and respect the AKC COVID-19 Best Practices Guidelines for Conformation.

AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB SUGGESTED BEST PRACTICES

The AKC supports each club's informed decision to reschedule, postpone or cancel their respective events, as well as supporting club's ready to hold events in locations that are open and permit gatherings. As events resume across the country, people need to feel safe while enjoying their dog activities. The AKC encourages clubs to take appropriate precautions for the benefit of their participants. Events need to be held in a manner that emphasizes the safety of participants and event officials over efficiency.

The following is a list of suggested best practices that may be helpful when planning or attending an event

GENERAL PRACTICES

- Clubs, officials and participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to the area and site where the event is held.
- Practice social distancing consistent with guidelines in effect at the time of the event. Avoid congregating to the extent possible.
- Consider wearing face coverings when in close proximity to others. Clubs should provide face coverings if desired for officials, judges and volunteers. Unless stated otherwise by government guidelines or club requirements, the AKC considers a face shield to be an acceptable face covering.
- 4. Consider wearing disposable or washable gloves.
- Wash hands as frequently as possible. Have disinfecting spray at bathroom facilities for people to spray door handles (or anything they touch). Consider hiring bathroom attendants to maintain maximum cleanliness.
- 6. If you utilize portable toilets, please ask for a hand washing station(s) to be delivered as well.
- 7. Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.
- 8. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
- 9. Avoid common use pens/pencils bring your own.
- 10. Disinfect surfaces in common use areas as often as possible (tables, chairs, doorknobs, etc.) Clubs and facilities may consider not providing chairs.
- Meals Avoid or stagger group lunches/dinners if possible. Hospitality areas should avoid community items such as salt and pepper shakers, condiments, creamers, etc. Participants should consider bringing their own lunch/drinks.

- 12. Vendors should follow retail guidelines for the area.
- 13. Parking Park with sufficient distance between vehicles if possible. If there is a parking fee, ask exhibitors to bring exact change.
- 14. Indoor show sites should work with facilities to have as many entrance/exit points open as possible. Hand sanitizer should be available at every entrance to the site and at multiple locations within the site.
- 15. Parking/unloading staff should wear face coverings and sanitize their hands following the assistance of each individual.

EVENT PRACTICES - EXHIBITORS

- * Prepare to be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring a generator for electricity, bring personal use face masks.
- * Know the armband numbers for your entries before going to the ring. Bring rubber bands or armband clips to secure the armband.
- * Do not congregate at the ring or ring gate.
- * While showing your dog, maintain social distances with other exhibitors.

GROOMING

- Recommend grooming beside the exhibitor's vehicle including the use of pop-up tents should weather conditions warrant.
- * Design layout of grooming areas and spaces to comply with social distancing guidelines in place at the time. Marking off individual grooming spaces is encouraged.
- Prohibit the use of forced air dryers in indoor grooming areas.

JUDGING

Judging is where the ability to socially distance becomes challenging. Taking care to protect the parties will require a concerted effort between the judge, steward, and exhibitors.

- * Judges should consider wearing face coverings if not otherwise required.
- * All classes should be called in catalog order to provide order and efficiency.
- Judges must practice ring awareness, be conscious of spacing, and take appropriate measures to avoid crowding of exhibitors.
- * Judges are to have the exhibitor display the oral exam and may personally examine the mouth ONLY if absolutely necessary. By nature of the procedure, judges must conduct thumb exams.
- * Judges should sanitize hands after examining each entry. Re-examination of dogs should be minimized.
- * Judges are encouraged to personally pull ribbons for placements. Coupled with frequent hand sanitizing, this will help mitigate contact exposure.
- * Equipment used to measure and/or weigh dogs must be sanitized before and after each use.
- * Clubs should consider providing boxed lunches for judges and volunteers.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Photographers should consider using a process where a photo of the judge is added to the photo of the dog.

- * Consider taking photos of each judge in the morning as though they were standing for an award photo.
- Take win photos without judges
- * Digitally insert the judge with the wins to finalize the photo.
- * Consider not using trophy presenters.

Participants are expected to follow state, local government, facility, and event guidelines. Clubs should be prepared to enforce the guidelines that apply to their event. The conformation field reps will assist as always in an advisory capacity.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog - Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes or if it is a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed Competition or may be entered for Stud dog Class only at the regular entry fee. The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes and MUST be indicated as "GET" in the additional class box on the entry form. The Stud Dog unit shall be

considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class – Both dogs in each Brace, regardless of sex, must have at least one common owner. Will require a fee of \$20.00 for the Brace as a Unit if entered as an additional class. The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of entry. If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in another class it must be entered "For Brace Only", fee is \$25.00. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes "Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated "Brace No. 1" "Brace No. 2" etc.



The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
